- **Weekly Foot Care Clinic** continues every Wednesday morning – please call 360-390-4014 and select option #3 for information or to make an appointment.
- **WIC** (Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children) has resumed their regular schedule at Tri Area – on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month. Call County Public Health WIC at 360-385-9432.
- **First Steps, the YMCA Family Resource Navigator and Peninsula College's Outreach** folks are now in the building on the same day/time as WIC – so please check the calendar elsewhere on this webpage and be in touch with them for appointments.
