Clallam/Jefferson RSVP Honors Volunteers



An amazing federal and state funded program called Retired & Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) of Clallam and Jefferson counties recognizes and honors volunteers each year. Awards are presented to volunteers for hours worked between April 1st and March 31st each year. The non-profit agency Olympic Community Action Programs (OlyCAP) sponsors both the RSVP program and volunteers with North Olympic Volunteer Corps (NOVC). More than 158 volunteers earned awards for their part in serving a total of 85,691 total hours last year. In all, there were over 400 OlyCAP volunteers serving communities on the Olympic Peninsula last year.

Thousands of service hours are donated annually by program volunteers to partner agencies who provide for emergency food distribution, tutoring of youth, delivering meals and transporting senior adults to medical appointments, helping with basic household tasks, providing service referrals to military veterans and family members, giving respite adult day care to family members, helping at community centers to offer senior nutrition meals, programming with KSQM radio, and assisting customers to reference materials at the law library in Pot Angeles. We have 90 people waiting to return to volunteer service after the virus fades away. 307 volunteers have remained active (despite the pandemic) assisting in a number of job placement locations.

The RSVP program funded through grants from the Corporation of National and Community Service, Washington State Department of Commerce, and OlyCAP focuses on alleviating loneliness in seniors; supporting education and school readiness goals; providing emergency food to families; supporting home bound seniors with transportation and meal needs so that senior adults can continue to live at home as they age, services to veterans and family members, and respite care to caregivers through the ENCORE- Adult Day Care Program.

RSVP was established by congress in 1965 and is a Senior Corps program. OlyCAP has sponsored RSVP since 1972 and in recent years added the North Olympic Volunteer Corps program (NOVC) which supports volunteers 18 to 54 years of age. They work at many of the same sites as RSVP volunteers. There are additional NOVC sites which support non-grant funded services.

Both programs provide Volunteer Liability Insurance coverage for volunteers if they are injured while working for out-of-pocket expenses only. The best benefit for volunteers who participate is socialization with co-workers and customers/clients who applaud services provided. Each year we celebrate the hard work achieved and the many people who were helped at an annual volunteer appreciation. In the summer months we distribute President's Volunteer Service Award pins to those who worked 100+ hours= Bronze, 250-499=Silver, 500 plus hours=Gold.
