#### The Brinnon Bookmobile

"Feeding Minds, Fueling Dreams" is the mission of the Jefferson County Library District, and "Our vision is for a thriving community empowered by knowledge". The Jefferson County bookmobile is an embodiment of this spirit by bringing the library services to children and adults who may not be able to get to the library easily.

For many years, the bookmobile stopped at Johnston Realty and used their hookup, but now it is more conveniently located at the County owned Brinnon Community Center. There is a section inside for books to borrow 7 days a week. Jamie Pena, library staffer, is available for computer help. He conducts free computer classes at the library in Port Hadlock for Seniors too. The Community Center is open 7 days a week. The bookmobile is here on Tuesdays 10-12 and Saturdays 10:30-12:30. There is a convenient book drop for returning books outside.

Bookmobile staffers are friendly and helpful, as well as being intrepid, courageous drivers, traveling not only to Brinnon and Quilcene but also Cape George, Coyle, Gardiner, Paradise Bay, and Port Ludlow in all kinds of weather, 52 weeks a year. It must be quite an adventure every day.

In 1978, the Jefferson County Rural Library District was created to develop and maintain library services in the County. First located at Chimacum School in a portable classroom, then a rental facility and presently the library at 620 Cedar Avenue, Port Hadlock, next to the school, open 7 days a week.

The bookmobile collections include regular and large print books, magazines, audiobooks, children's materials, as well as music CDs and DVDs for all ages. Requests for items at other libraries are available at no charge. A library card is easily obtained on the bookmobile. There is a new chairlift for easy access for the elderly and disabled.

The bookmobile gives a magic carpet ride of adventure and magic to all those who wish to expand their minds and explore the world around them. Many thanks to all those who bring this opportunity to us.

#### CALL 911 FIRST We're Here for You

When you're experiencing chest pain or shortness of breath, please call 911 first, not your doctor's office or nurse advice line. Seconds count, and our crews are trained and ready to respond immediately. Let us come to you.

We understand that some folks like to swing by the station when they're concerned. While we love our community, it is important to know that we're not always in the building. We're often out doing inspections, running calls, or working in the field. So if you stop by and no one answers, it does not mean we're unavailable. It means we're out there doing our job. Calling 911 ensures we're dispatched to you without delay.

Also, and this is crucial, please don't drive yourself to the hospital, and don't have a friend or family member do it either. Let us take you. We monitor which hospitals are up, down, full, or rerouting patients. Not all hospitals offer the same services, and just like you wouldn't take your car to a transmission shop for a brake job, you don't want to end up at the wrong hospital during a serious emergency.

Our crews are trained to assess and determine the best destination for your care, whether you're having a heart attack or just need stitches. And just because you call 911 does not mean you're automatically going by ambulance. We'll help you make that decision based on what's best for your situation.

Worried about the cost? Don't be. If you're a Brinnon resident, you won't be billed out-of-pocket for ambulance transport. We may bill your insurance, but if they deny it, so do we. Our focus is on your care, not your wallet.

At Brinnon Fire, we've got you covered 24/7. When in doubt, call us out.


